**Introduction:** What is your favorite vacation spot?

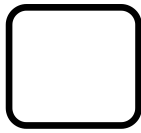
### 1. Watch Video Segment 1:

- a. Stories and testimonials are a powerful way to share how the gospel has changed your life. Take a few minutes to write out your story. If time seems short, or if writing out the whole thing seems intimidating, consider sketching out the high points. For example: How you came to faith. What it was like before knowing God or having a church home. What life is like now after knowing the full forgiveness you possess in Christ? How does knowing Jesus change your everyday?
- b. The Bible records two times when Paul shared his story with others. In [Acts 22:1-21](#) he addresses the crowd in Jerusalem and in [Acts 26:11-23](#) as he addresses King Agrippa. Why is it important to tailor your story to the person to whom you are telling it?

### 2. Watch Video Segment 2:

- a. What do you think are some of the challenges for someone to come to your church for the first time?
- b. What might you do to help them overcome each of the challenges you identified?
- c. What challenges you most about inviting people to church?
- d. What might be some things you can do or remember to help you overcome these challenges?

3. **Watch Video Segment 3:** Read [Esther 4](#). Is there someone who doesn't believe that God has brought into your life "for such a time as this"? What is his/her name? How might you intentionally show love to that person in the near future? How might your story encourage him/her?

### Next Steps

- **Read** Hebrews 11:1-3 and 11:8-10. How does FAITH “inform” our lives so that we live differently than the world that does not SEE Jesus?
- **Ponder** the impact Paul’s conversion had on the rest of his life. Read Philippians 1:12-29. Paul saw Jesus on the Road to Damascus and it changed the “story line” of his life!
- **Consider** the story of your life as God has written it thus far. What chapters make you smile? What chapters make you wince? What chapters make you cry? How well does the last chapter of your life “inform” TODAY? How can you assist God in his writing between now and the day of your death?
