- I. Where have you seen God active in your life this week? What are the highlights of his common grace for you—the rain and the sunshine that he gives to believer and unbeliever alike? What are the challenges with which he is training you?
- 2. How has God spoken into your life this past week through your personal Bible study and devotion time? Ahha's? Challenges? Comfort?
- 3. Let's pool physics with our faith walk in light of the sermon and sermon theme from John 15:9-17, A Joyful Life Turns on the Love of God.
- a. What force keeps a gyroscope oriented on a plane?
- b. What force keeps the Christian oriented with his/her God? Refer to I John 4:7-II to "orient the gyroscope."
- c. What happens to a gyroscope if the energy that drives the spinning wheel decreases or ceases? How do you reinvigorate a gyroscope?
 - How do these truths enlighten our faith walk? What is the KEY to the joyful life turning on the love of God?
- 4. Read all of 2 John. It is a thought-provoking commentary on the love of God and that love's intersection with God's truth. What is the relationship between truth and love for the Christian on our earthly walk? What is the challenge for the Christian keeping in mind both God's truth and his love?
- 5. In what unique ways do you show the Father's love in Jesus ("fruit that lasts") that might help the group grow in bearing more fruit? (share the definition of fruit that lasts?)
- 6. That's a wrap! Pray yourselves out in the Name of Jesus.
