- 6. Visit the gospel from Sunday, **John 7:1-18.** How "real" was Jesus' earthly journey? What was the message of his brothers? What was Jesus' message when finally he spoke at the festival?

7. Reread God's purpose in his Creation using **John 3:16. Pray yourselves out** of your discussion keeping "the main thing, the main thing."
