Sing, choirs of angels, Sing in exultation; Sing, all ye citizens of heav'n above. Glory to God, all Glory in the highest.


M Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people.

FIRST LESSON Hebrews 1:1-9

In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, ² but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe. ³ The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven. ⁴ So he became as much superior to the angels as the name he has inherited is superior to theirs.

The Son Superior to Angels

- ⁵For to which of the angels did God ever say,
- "You are my Son; today I have become your Father"?

Or again,

- "I will be his Father,
- ⁶ And again, when God brings his firstborn into the world, he says,
- "Let all God's angels worship him."
- ⁷ In speaking of the angels he says,
- "He makes his angels spirits, and his servants flames of fire."
- ⁸But about the Son he says,
- "Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever; a scepter of justice will be the scepter of your kingdom.
- ⁹You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; therefore God, your God, has set you above your companions by anointing you with the oil of joy."

- All The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.
