THE LESSON

God has made his name known to us in the Bible. The Bible records many names for God (see Bible links at left).

From his name we know what God is like, what he has done, what he still does, and what he will do. Since God's name and all he has told us about himself are holy, God wants us to show great respect for his name and for what he has done for us and all people.

We know that we have not always honored God's name. We trust, however, that God will forgive us for Jesus' sake.

THE POINT

We respect God's name when we talk.

1. Of all God's different names, which one do you like best? Why?
2. Each of the special names for God carry different meanings. Why do you think the Bible records so many of these names?
3. Have any unique names or "nicknames" been given to you or people you know? Share.
4. Why have these nicknames been given to you/them?
5. In the video, names for God were spoken in different languages from people in different countries. The names for God did not sound the same, and the people speaking were not the same, but what can we say about the love God has for all people?
6. Even though Christians from countries around the world are different, what makes them all the same?
7. How would being able to speak different languages help a person to share Jesus?
8. Read the Christmas prophesy below out loud. It shares some beautiful names for Jesus.

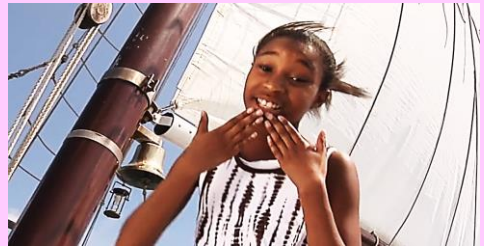
