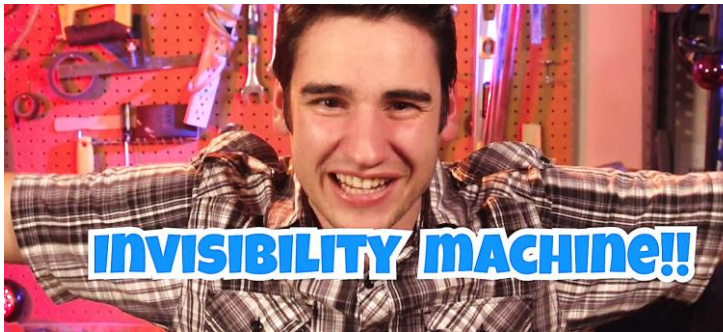

4. How did Cami herself actually show Andy what selfless means?
5. Selfless means to care about others more than you care about yourself. Tell of a time when someone was selfless with you?
6. Tell of a time you were selfless with someone.
7. The opposite of selfless is “selfish.” Have you ever been selfish? Share.
8. What specific verses from this week’s Bible lesson, Philippians 2:1-11, relate to the main point of this video?
9. What does [Philippians 2:5-8](#) say Jesus did to show his selflessness for us?
10. Because Jesus selflessly served and saved you, what will you want to do for others?
