Well, God brought him back again later that evening, and, unable to contain himself, he poured out in private a whole lot of things that a 20-year-old should not have had to experience. His statement after hearing the Word, "I never thought I'd find God in Mahahual."

Some make their way to Mahahual to run away from problems, and they find us ready with compassion, the Word and the grace of God. We ask the Lord to keep using Cruz de Cristo as an instrument to bring them closer to Him and his saving forgiveness in Christ.








The building project continues! The cement floor was recently poured on the second level of the education center. The lighthouse structure is taking shape and the roof of the worship area is in process.
